

What's been happening...

#### TWP MEETING

The latest meeting of the Transition Working Party (TWP) took place on Thursday 30 April 2009.

### SCHOOL BUILDING DESIGN UNDERWAY

A second meeting has taken place to progress the design for the new school building. The focus of the session was to think about the internal layout of the building.

We will be consulting with the wider group of parents, staff and local residents to see what you think towards the end of June and hope that you will be able to come along and let us have your views on the initial plans for the building.

#### STAFF RECRUITMENT

We had hoped to let you know the outcomes of the staff recruitment in this edition however the recruitment process is still underway. We will let you know in June which staff will be working at the school from September, along with details of teaching groups.

Your questions revisited... and some new questions and answers too...

#### **HOW WILL THE CLASSES BE ORGANISED?**

Class organisation will be confirmed to everyone in June. This will include a list of pupils in each class and which teachers will be leading the classes. As confirmed previously, the classes will be organised according to age as this is the most fair and practical way.

#### WHAT WILL THE START AND FINISH TIMES BE?

Based on feedback from the school opening times consultation, we can now confirm that School opening times will be:

Key Stage 2: 8:40am to 3:05pm Key Stage 1: 8:50am to 3:15pm

Please note that the school doors will open 5 minutes before opening times and staff will be available to receive the children.

#### WHAT WILL THE SCHOOL UNIFORM BE?

As indicated above, we have received feedback from some parents about the school uniform colour but we had not received all responses by the time the TWP meeting took place.

We do already know that a lot of you would like to see sweatshirts and fleeces included as part of the uniform and will confirm all the items and colour in a few weeks' time.

Please note that the agreed school uniform will need to be worn from the first day of term in September 2009.

### WHAT ABOUT OUR OLD SCHOOL UNIFORMS?

There will be a school uniform collection during the first week of term in September 2009. All uniform items will be given to charity. Please ensure that they are washed and folded when you bring them to school.

## WHAT ABOUT BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL PROVISION?

#### WHAT ABOUT SCHOOL ACTIVITIES AND CLUBS?

Clubs and activities will still be available for everyone. The types of clubs change from term to term, so a list of available activities will be shared in September.

#### WHAT ABOUT A WALKING BUS SCHEME?

Based on your feedback we are currently considering whether we will be able to establish a walking bus scheme and will let you know when we are able to confirm any details.

#### WILL THERE STILL BE FUNDING FOR THE NEW BUILDING?

Some of you have voiced concerns about whether money will be available to pay for the new school building given the current economic climate. The Council uses a number of sources to fund building work including grants, supported borrowing and capital receipts. The Council will set aside sufficient funding from these various sources to ensure that the new school building can be completed.
