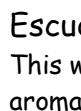
AWARD WINNING WINES

The International Wine Challenge and the Brussels Concours Mondial are two of the most prestigious wine competitions in the world. Both have recently announced the results of the 2009 competitions. We are very proud to announce that a number of the wines we stock have won prizes. All are available to order immediately.



Selvarossa Salice Salentino 2005 (Puglia) 9.95

Double gold medal winner. The judges said *"Rich, deep, brooding plum and bramble nose. Oaky palate seamlessly stitched through the fruit. Dense and rich with a sweet fruit finish. Perfect balance."*



Escudo Rojo 2007 (Maipo Valley, Chile) 9.95

This wine has a full, generous nose that reveals attractive blackcurrant and liquorice aromas with spicier touches of nutmeg. Round and rich on the palate, with chocolate, vanilla, caramel and pepper notes. The long, full-bodied and expressive finish combines delicious and persistent fruit and roasted coffee flavours.



Caliterra Tributo Shiraz 2007 (Colchagua Valley, Chile) 9.45

The judges said *"Raspberry and loganberry nose. Earthiness with lots of vanilla oak. Balanced and stylish with good grip and length."*



Caliterra Tributo Carmenere 2007 (Colchagua V, Chile) 9.45

The judges said *"Blackcurrant nose with bitter chocolate. Softish tannins. Juicy with good depth of flavour"*



Caliterra Tributo Sauvignon Blanc 2008 (Chile) 9.45

The judges said *"Intense aromas of citrus zest and grapefruit with a soft, sweet attack. Restrained and balanced."*



Brindisi Rosso 2007 (Puglia, Italy) 6.95

Gorgeous full-bodied, intense, ruby red wine with velvety smooth, dark fruit flavours



Squinzano Rosso 2007 (Puglia)
