R239 Reinales Tempranillo 2006 (La Tierra de Castilla, Spain) 4.90

Medium bodied, fruity, quaffable wine, from this up and coming region. Try it with your tapas.

R240 Il Mendione Primario 2003 (Campania, Italy) 5.10

Robust, rich, concentrated wine produced mainly from the local Aglianico grape.. 18 months in oak has given the wine great structure and character. will continue to develop for another 5-8 years. Fantastic value



R265 Le Sabounet 2008 (France) 5.45

The family of Roger Sabon have been producing top quality Chateauneuf du Pape for over 50 years and recently planted a couple of hectares with new vines. This is their first vintage. Fresh, light, airy and very, very quaffable.

R206 Hillview Shiraz Cabernet 2004 (Sth Australia) 6.10

Easy drinking soft, flavoursome wine displaying rich berry characteristics with hints of spice. Ideal for drinking with or without food but most of all with enjoyment. Tremendous value.

R200 Los Robles Carmenere 2006 (Chile) FAIRTRADE 5.60

Fairtrade Labelling Organisation International is a "not for profit" organisation who assist disadvantaged communities earn a livelihood. This characterful wine displays warm plum and damson flavours with a hint of chocolate, before a long, soft finish. Seen at £6.95 on t'internet

R244 Stoney Vale Cabernet Sauvignon / Shiraz 2007 (SE Australia) 5.60

Full flavoured and smooth with soft, ripe, blackcurrant and bramble fruit. Great on its own but even better with friends.

R215 Ugarte Cosecha 2005 (Rioja) 5.80

Rugged wine with hints of cedar and currants. Drinks well above its price.

R266 Mercedes Eguren Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 (Tierra de Castilla, Spain) 6.10
Somewhat unusual to see this varietal grown in Spain. Big, chunky, meaty red, aged for 6 months in oak. Ripe and fruity with a herbaceous lift

R170 Casa Silva Carmenere 2007 (Colchagua Valley Chile) 6.15
Elegant wine with soft , plummy fruit. From the 5th generation of this family producer who have won numerous awards including "Best Chilean Carmenere" and "Best South American Producer".

R228 Brindisi Rosso 2006 (Italy) 6.15
Latest vintage from this tremendous medal winning co-operative. Silver medal at the 2008 Brussels Concours Mondial.. Round, intense wine with great fruit and substance.

R252 Dante Robino Malbec 2006 (Argentina) 6.15
Packed with fragrant, black cherry flavours with soft hints of vanilla and spice. Firm and burly but well rounded through oak aging. The perfect partner for steak.

R253 Dante Robino Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 6.15
Complex, well balanced wine showing lovely blackcurrant fruit with hints of mint. Excellent structure with soft tannins.

R254 Dante Robino Merlot 2005 6.15
Soft, mellow, smooth with touches of plum and red berries.

R267 Dante Robino Bonarda 2006 6.15
Lively, intense, harmonious wine from this little known but highly individualistic grape variety.
Gold medal winner at the Hyatt International Wine Awards.

R207 Hillsview Langhorne Creek Shiraz 2003 (Sth Australia) 6.40
Characterful wine displaying rich berry fruit with spicy overtones. Great depth of flavour

R202 San Cristobal 1492 Malbec 2006 Argentina 6.50
In 1492 Colombus sailed the ocean blue.....and discovered the Mendoza Valley, a Garden of Eden for the growing of grapes. Beautiful, hand-crafted, harmonious wine that brilliantly expresses the characteristics of Argentina's signature grape. Bronze medal winner at the International Wine Challenge.

R066 Torres Santa Digna Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 2007 (Chile) 6.60
Clear, ruby wine with satisfying liquorice and blackcurrant aromas. Smooth ,intense, elegant, meaty wine with a long finish. Gold medal winner at the Japan Wine Challenge.

R099 Torres Santa Digna Merlot Reserva 2007 (Chile) 6.60
Aromatic on the nostrils, and on the tongue plum and blackberry with hints of liquorice and vanilla. Oak aged with a long lingering aftertaste.

R268 A'Mano Primitivo 2007 (Puglia, Italy) 7.00
Loaded with rich, ripe berry fruit and soft tannins. Rich, deep flavours and concentrated elegance. A wine that reveals new treasures with each sip bellissima !!!!

R208 Torres Santa Digna Carmenere Reserve 2006 7.15
Delightful aromas of cassis with hints of eucalyptus. Sweet fruit on the palate with nuances of vanilla, leather , black pepper and cloves.

R209 Torres Santa Digna Syrah Reserve 2006 7.15
Something of a rarity in Chile, this Shiraz displays intense, purple colour and aromas of small black fruits, violets and redcurrant. Aged 6 months in oak.

R256 Evohe 2008 (Bajo Aragon) Spain 7.15
Produced from 100% Garnacha grapes from old vines. This is an explosive, rich, concentrated, deep wine, offering a gorgeous nose of ripe red fruits, kirsch liqueur, and white pepper.. This fruit-driven wine has substantial black fruit flavours, a subtle texture, and very good length. This is Garnacha at its best. Highly rated by Oz Clark and went down fantastically at our recent tasting



R247 Squinzano Rosso 2006 (Italy) 7.15
Don't you just love the name?? got absolutely squinzanoed last night haha.
But don't be fooled by the name however, this is a serious wine which won the **Gold Medal at the Brussels Concours Mondial.**



R257 The Black Shiraz 2007 (SE Australia) 7.15
Deep colour, huge palate and high alcohol. Strong blackberry and plum aromas over toast, vanilla and spice. The palate is full flavoured and intense with rich blackberry, plum, blueberry and spicy characters and a lingering smoky finish. Does what it says on the tin !!!! Great with rich casseroles and strong cheeses.

R258 Quercia Dei Corvi Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2005 (Italy) 7.15
As far removed from the cheap supermarket versions as you could imagine. Excellent body and packed with vibrant fruit. Fabulous.

R255 Tyrrell's Pinot Noir 2008 (NSW, Australia) 7.40
Softer style of red with complex "gamey" fruit flavours and a fleshy texture. Delightful served slightly chilled but equally good at room temperature

R259 Peique Tinto Mencia (Bierzo, NW Spain) 2008 7.40
Produced from the Mencia grape in the cooler Bierzo region of NW Spain. Three generations of the Peique family have dedicated themselves to producing quality red wines. Intense aroma on the nose with hints of ripe fruit. Full-bodied in the mouth, good balance of flavours and very fruity.

- R219 Heredad Ugarte Crianza 2004 (Rioja)** 7.40
Smooth, refined wine which is nicely softened at the edges. Nursed for 15 months in American oak barriques. *Seen at £8 on t'internet*
- R269 Firestick Cabernet Merlot 2008 (Australia)** 7.40
Displays the classic Cabernet Sauvignon characteristics of blackcurrants and blueberries which combine beautifully with the soft spiciness of the Merlot. You know when a great wine strikes !!!
- R270 El Coto Crianza 2005 (Rioja, Spain)** 7.85
Produced from the best quality Tempranillo grapes grown on the highest slopes. Fermented and matured in oak barriques to produce a harmonious wine with a perfect balance between oak and fruit.
- R260 Cremaschi Furlotti Pinot Noir Reserve Reserva 2007 (Chile)** 8.15
Light , delicate sophisticated wine displaying floral aromas with hints of ripe raspberries. Complex in the mouth and with a refined , smoky finish.
- R231 Tormenta Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile)** **ORGANIC** 8.15
Absolutely fabulous Cabernet Sauvignon displaying spicy liquorice and blackcurrant fruit. Aged for 6 months in American and French oak barriques to produce a gorgeous, smooth lingering finish. Went down a storm at our tasting!!
- R250 Lagunilla Reserva 2003 (Rioja, Spain)** 8.15
Smooth, round, elegant wine with toasty aromas and forest fruit on the palate. Soft tannins with hints of oak and a long, finish. *Seen at £9.95 on t'internet. Tremendous value for a reserve.*
- R210 Blewitt Springs Adelaide Shiraz 2003 (Sth Australia)** 8.65
A full-bodied and powerfully flavoured Shiraz with robust fruit and soft complementary oak. This wine was aged in small French oak barrels for 12 months and will steadily mature in bottle for the next 4 to 6 years. *Bronze medal winner at the 2005 Internatinal Wine Challenge.*
- R211 Blewitt Springs Malbec2003 (Sth Australia)** 8.65
A full bodied, full flavoured, powerful wine.s. A complex palate of opulent fruit provides a big mouthful and long silk like finish. An Australian classic which will blow your mind!!
- R238 Mud House Pinot Noir 2007 (Marlborough, New Zealand)** 9.15
This Pinot Noir offers aromas of cherries, currants and plums with attractive integrated savoury mushrooms and toasty oak. Use of a mixture of new and old French oak, results in a soft full palate with cherry notes, red current and plum. Absolutely gorgeous
- R271 Ugarte Cinquiente 2007 (Rioja)** 9.50
Specially produced one-off to celebrate the 50th anniversary of this family run bodega. Creamy red packed with ripe fruit. Seamlessly softened with oak. Gorgeous



R261 Caliterra Tributo Carmenere 2007 (Colchagua V, Chile) 9.65
Silver medal winner at the 2009 Concours Mondiale. The judges said "Blackcurrant nose with bitter chocolate. Softish tannins. Juicy with good depth of flavour"



R262 Escudo Rojo 2008 (Maipo Valley, Chile) 10.25
Produced by an award winning enterprise funded by Baron Philippe de Rothschild, and featuring a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere and Syrah grapes. Has a full, generous nose that reveals attractive blackcurrant, liquorice and cherry brandy aromas with touches of nutmeg. Round and rich on the palate with notes of chocolate, vanilla, caramel and pepper. The long, full-bodied finish combines delicious fruit and roasted coffee flavours. *Recently seen at £13.99 in Manchester*

R236 Wicks Estate Adelaide Hills Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 10.25
Blackcurrant and cassis combined with subtle hints of tobacco and chocolate. 12 months aging in French oak produces a finely balanced wine with delicate fruit flavours. Delicious!!!

R272 Dogajolo Rosso 2006 (Italy) 10.25
Beautiful, serious, robust Tuscan in the Chianti style. Produced from a blend of Sangiovese and Cab Sauv, vinified separately in oak casks. Went down really well at our recent tasting

R251 I Siglati Barolo 2003 (Italy) 11.25
Full, rich, complex wine with a cornucopia of flavours..... This is what the Italians do best. *RRP is £14.95...you won't find a better value Barolo anywhere.*

W 201 Monte Arcos 2007 (Campo de Borjo, Spain) 5.10
Fresh, vibrant, dry wine produced from a blend of Chardonnay and Viura grapes in northern Spain. Aromatic with lively citrus fruit and a crisp delicate finish. *Seen at £5.45 on t'internet*

W190 Cantavida Sauvignon Blanc 2008 (Central Valley, Chile) 5.10
Pale, delicate, crisp, aromatic Sauvignon with overtones of peach

W202 Celso Greciano (Sicily) 5.40
Traditional Sicilian grape with delicate pear and apple aromas. Savoury, flavoursome, tangy and crisp on the palate with intense notes of almond and citrus. Tremendous value.

W156 Amapola Semi Dulce 2006 (Penedes, Spain) 5.40
Light, fruity, medium-sweet Spaniello, with hints of poppy seeds.

W096 Honore de Berticot Sauvignon 2006 (Cote de Duras, France) 5.60
Previous vintages have proved themselves to be extremely popular. Fresh, fruity, dry white with hints of gooseberries. Forget your prejudices and give this a go. Fantastic !!!

W191 Ca' Lunghetta Pinot Grigio 2008 (Venezie, Italy) 5.60
Delightful, well balanced fruity wine with good body. Soft and and dry in the mouth. Very moreish

W088 Bornos Sindo 2007/8 (Rueda, Spain) 5.80
One of the best wines I have ever tasted in this price range. Aromatic and fruity. Delicious.

W181 Dom.Delaunay TYDY Sauvignon Blanc 2008 (VdeP Jardin de la France) 5.60
Zippy, fragrant full-flavoured wine from the Loire Valley which punches way above its weight.
Seen on t'internet at various priced between £6.50 and 7.99 which makes this fantastic value.

W192 McGuigans Gewurtztraminer / Riesling 2006 (Australia) 5.60
Clean well balanced, medium-dry wine with a lingering sweetish finish. Displays a veritable fruit cocktail of flavourspineapple and melon, grapefruit and lime....Gorgeous

W206 Currabridge Unoaked Chardonnay 2009 (Sth Asustralia) 5.99
Return of an old favourite. Delightful crisp, clean tasting wine. Peach and ripe melon on the nose whilst packed with tropical fruit in the mouth. *Seen on ti'internet at £6.50*

W194 Araldica "La Madonnina" 2007 (Gavi, Italy) 6.10
Produced from the Cortese grape around the small town of Gavi. Clean, dry , elegant wine with lemony characteristics and the merest hint of oak. *Seen at £8.15 on the internet.*

W203 Bleasdale Verdelho 2005 (Australia) 6.10
This winery was established in 1850 by Frank Potts , one of the original settlers of Langhorne Creek. 150 years later it is still in the family. The 2005 Verdelho exhibits aromas of orange blossom, kiwi fruit and melons and displays flavours of ripe citrus and pineapple.

W210 Opal Ridge Gewurtztraminer Verdelho 2008 (SE Australia) 6.10
A delicious off-dry blend offering aromas of lemon and lime. Fruity and flavoursome with a delicious zesty finish. Perfect as an aperitif or with spicy asian cuisine

- W211 Dante Robino Chardonnay 2008 (Mendoza, Argentina)** 6.40
Soft, fresh harmonious wine with delicate aromas and flavours of pears and apples.
- W058 Torres Santa Digna Sauvignon Blanc Reserva 2008 (Chile)** 6.40

- W165 Torres Santa Digna Chardonnay 2005 (Chile)** 6.40
Delightful, elegant lightly oaked wine with hints of vanilla, mango and coconut .
- W163 Hillsvie Barossa Valley Riesling 2005 (Australia)** 6.40
Crisp, clean, vibrant, dry white characterized by lemon and lime influences. Perfect with Thai food.
- W183 San Cristobal Verdelho 2006 (Argentina)** 6.50
Rich floral and fruit bouquet is followed by citrus and melon flavors, balanced acidity, and a long finish. This crisp Verdelho has good body, character, and balance.
- W152 Benchmark Chardonnay 2008 (SE Australia)** 6.65
Well-balanced , crisp wine with good acidity . Citrus and tropical fruit flavours with a silky feel in the mouth.
- W005 Borgata Pinot Grigio Garganega 2007 (Puglia, Italy)** 6.65

- W149 Vouvray Les Tufiers 2005 (Loire Valley)** 6.65
There is a massive gap in the market for medium sweet wines, and this fills it splendidly. Concentrated, luscious fruit, balanced by delicious acidity. Produced in the village of Vouvray.
- W184 Santa Rita 120 Riesling 2007 (Casablanca Valley, Chile)** 6.80
Delightful wine with refreshing youthful acidity and hints of citrus blossom and apricots. As light and airy as a floating butterfly.
- W212 A' Mano Fiano Greco 2008 (Puglia, Italy)** 7.10
Gorgeous blend of two indigenous grapes, the aromatic Fiano and the full bodied and elegant Greco. Clean, fresh and lively with a zesty finish. [Seen at £7.95 on t'internet](#)
- W186 Hazendal Sauvignon Blanc 2007 (Stellenbosch, S Africa)** 7.10
Fresh, vibrant wine packed with gooseberry fruit and hints of Granny Smith apples and ripe cantaloupe melons. It's winemaker, Ronell Wild, was recently voted South African winemaker of the year.

- W213 Broadfield Madeleine Angevine 2005 (Herefordshire)** **7.10**
 A rounded, full-bodied yet delicate wine echoing evocative scents of an English garden; this barrel fermented new-comer delivers a depth of flavour that is as delicious as it is distinctive. Terrific with poultry or fish, it also teams smoothly with many desserts and is simply special just on its own. Fly the flag !!!
- W198 Babich Sauvignon Blanc 2007 (Marlborough, New Zealand)** **7.45**
 Full-on, intense, exuberant wine packed with flavours of tropical fruits and fresh herbs. Long, refreshing limey finish. A real joy!!! **Recently seen at over £10.25 at a Cheshire independent.**
- W214 Firestick Hunter Valley Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2008** **7.45**
 Palest lime in colour with lime and lemon grass aromas. Delightful, clean and refreshing in the mouth with delicate hints of passion fruit and gooseberries. Went down a bomb at our September tasting and at 10% is perfect for those who prefer lighter wines.
- W204 Prado Rey Verdejo (Rueda 2008)** **7.65**
 This wine, with appealing greenish tones, features aromas of exotic fruit with aniseed hints. It gives an unctuous, fleshy, fat impression in the mouth with an excellent aftertaste. Ideal accompaniment to rice-dishes, seafood and fish.
- W188 Tormenta Viognier 2007 (Chile)** **ORGANIC** **8.15**
 Fuller bodied white with intense notes of grapefruit and roses. Fresh, silky, refined finish. Very popular amongst the chattering classes of Hampstead.
- W199 Tormenta Sauvignon Blanc 2008 (Chile)** **ORGANIC** **8.15**
 A wine of great aromatic intensity, characterized by passion fruit, carambola, and mango with citric and mineral touches. On the palate the wine is fresh and full-bodied giving way to aromas of passion fruit and grapefruit. Long, exquisite finish which seems to go on for ever. Gorgeous.
- W216 Duc de Mornet Picpoul de Pinet 2008 (France)** **8.15**
 Absolutely gorgeous dry, fruity white from the Mediterranean coast which goes perfectly with seafood. **Gold medal winner at the 2009 Paris Concours General**
- W217 Groote Post Unwooded Chardonnay 2006 (Sth Africa)** **8.15**
 The Prentz family have been producing wines since 1706. Lovely, varietal , expressive wine, displaying pure fruit characteristics and a firm backbone.

- W218 Mud House Waipara Riesling 2008 (New Zealand)** **8.65**
 Beautifully balanced dry wine with aromas of oranges and mandarins and flavours of citrus and apples in the mouth.

W189 Wicks Estate Adelaide Hills Riesling 2007 (S. Australia) 10.15
Fantastic wine from one of our favourite Australian family run wineries. Aromatic with intense fruit. Drinking beautifully now and also has excellent aging potential.

W220 Cloudy Bay Chardonnay 2006 (New Zealand) 19.45
Gorgeous, full flavoured, complex wine from this iconic winery. The scent of white flowers and fresh citrus fruits all temptingly mingled with the savoury complexity of toasted nuts and oatmeal. The silky palate shows lively citrus flavours and seamlessly integrated smoky French oak.

Fabulous, floral, non-conformist rose with tempting sensuality. Fresh, fruity body with hints of cranberry and redcurrant. The best rose I have ever tasted..... Voted the best Rose at Vinexpo

Ro 08 Mediodia Rosado Sur Lie (Navarra, Spain) 6.95

S012 Firestick Brut NV (Australia) 8.15

Apple and peach flavours with a fine effervescence and crisp, lingering finish. Produced from a blend of Semillon and Chardonnay grapes.....the perfect aperitif.



S011 Prosecco Marzemino Rosato (Italy) 8.85
