Grant Burge Filsell Vineyard Old Vines Shiraz 2004 (Sth Australia)

Produced from grapes grown on century old vines in the highly acclaimed Filsell Vineyard in the Barossa Valley. This exceptional Shiraz is almost black in colour, with a complex, perfumed nose of dark berries, oak, rich chocolate and liquorice. These luscious flavours dominate on the palate with firm tannins and balanced integrated oak. The finish is long and elegant, rounding off a wine of terrific finesse. Drinking fantastically now, and will develop its complexity for up to another 10 years. Very few left so don't hang about.

Balthazar Shiraz/Viognier (2002) Australia

Whopping humdinger of a wine with the highly unusual addition of a small amount of viognier which acts as both a flavour and aroma enhancer. Well worth investigating. Peter Lehmann Barossa Valley Shiraz 2002 (Australia)

Rich, warm, generous wine with intensely concentrated flavours, mellowed by light oak maturation.

In 2003 Lehmanns won awards for Best Australian producer and International Wine maker of the year.

Graham Beck Shiraz / Cabernet Sauvignon 2004 (Sth Africa)

Gorgeous wine characterized by huge berry flavours and enticing smoky spiciness.
